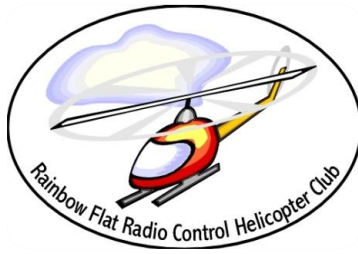

CLUB RULES

These club rules are set so that everyone using this field can do so in a safe and fun environment and must be complied with at all times when using the flying field. **Breaking these rules could result in termination of membership, visiting rights, damage, serious injury, or death.**

1. When entering or leaving the field, please ensure that the gate is shut and secure at all times as there are cattle and horses on the property.
2. All rubbish, including crashed models, must be taken away and disposed of properly. ***"You are responsible for your own rubbish"*** – not the club.
3. There is a 10km/h speed limit for all vehicles entering into the pits and parking area. Please be aware of other people and children using the field.
4. Family and friends of members are most welcome to come to the field under the supervision of that member. ***"You are responsible for your visitor's welfare"***. – not the club.
5. Children under the age of 10 must be supervised and accompanied by an adult or guardian at all times.
6. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated and could result in the termination of your membership.
7. **NO PERSON** is permitted to use the field to fly unless they are a member of the club or authorised visitor. New members wishing to join shall be accompanied by a current member of the club and must be approved by the committee if they intend to fly on the day.
8. Any person not a member and using the field will be referred to the police for trespassing on private property and charged.
9. Visiting pilots are limited to four (4) visits, they must then apply to become a member and approved prior to visiting to fly again.
10. Access to restricted areas whilst aircraft are flying is permitted only to those persons involved directly with the aircraft being flown.
11. The flying of helicopters has first priority over planes, and multi-rotors on the main flight line. If intending to fly your plane or multi-rotor in the main flying area, please announce your intention to fly to members before setting off to start up.
12. If multi-rotors wish to fly in the shared area while helicopters or planes are flying in the main flying area, they must fly low while the pilot in the main area must fly high.
13. **All aircraft shall only** be started or armed on, or beside the starting table outside the pits & carried out to the runway or starting grid, then carried back to the pits at the completion of the flight. Electrics must be disarmed prior to returning to the pits.
14. Planes may taxi out to the runway. When finished, planes may only taxi back as far as the main flight line, they must then be carried to the pits.
15. Planes are permitted to fly off the strip and are limited to a 20-minute flight.
16. A limit of 10 planes can be airborne at any one time.
17. No aircraft may be flown behind a pilot at the main flight position.
18. Anyone wishing to consume alcohol at the field may only do so when they've finished flying for the day. Their transmitter must be secured in its case and/or returned to a car. Aircraft may be left in the pits until departure.
19. All people attending this flying field must adhere to these club rules and restricted areas as shown on the Field Layout Diagram.
